FEE

St. Josephs School provides Convenient payment system to the Parents for paying their wards school fees. Annual as well as Quarter Payment system is acceptable in remitting the school fees. SJS accepts payment through POS, credit cards, debit cards and also remote payment system such as UPI and net banking. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application form and prospectus can be downloaded from the school website <https://stjosephislampur.edu.in/> and obtained from the school office on working days. Online application form is available, parents can access school portal to submit their wards duly filled in forms. Applications for admission to class LKG, UKG Grade I to Grade V are accepted from students of all faiths. However, admissions to other Grades will be taken against chance vacancies at the beginning of the school year. Admission will be done by a personal intercession with parents, the students must pass a written test of 50 marks. No admission is made until the student has passed a test for the essential class subjects. Parents/ Guardians are asked to fill the admission forms with at most accuracy. No subsequent changes will be permitted. A student who has attended a school cannot be admitted without a school leaving certificate from the school last attended.
